



GUIDELINES FOR EDUCATION GROUPS

To ensure your visit to GRAD is successful please observe the following guidelines:

BOOKING

Sessions in the gallery are available Tuesday-Friday, 10:30-17:30.

All learning (school, college and university) workshops, tours or self-guided visits (school, college, and university) must be booked in advance.

Please note that GRAD closes between exhibitions. Before booking it is important to check with a member of the Learning team that your visit will coincide with our exhibition programme.

Group supervision and Safety

Teachers are required to supervise their students at all times, with the following adult-to-student ratios:

1:10 for 06-11 year-olds 1:15 for 12-16 year-olds 1:20 for 16-18 year-olds

Teachers and accompanying adults are responsible for the behaviour of their group throughout their visit to the gallery and must never leave their group unattended.

Please note: all workshops and tours will take place in the gallery. Unfortunately we do not have a lunch space.

Use of photography and drawing materials inside the gallery.

Photography is permitted for private purposes only. Students are welcome to draw inside the gallery with dry materials: fine-tipped pens, crayons, pencils. Materials not permitted are paint, oil paint and other wet materials, permanent markers, charcoal and pastels.
